



Questions About Prayer

• What is prayer for?

The purpose of prayer is for us to get closer to God. When we tell God our worries, our concerns, that we are sorry for our sins, or thank Him for His help, God changes us. Just think: God is our Friend; God is our Father. So when we pray to Him, we are talking with Him like to our friends.

Psalm 17:6; John 16:24; Philippians 4:6.

• When we are bad, can we still pray?

۲

Definitely! Yes! We can pray at any time and anywhere. When we do wrong things, we need to talk with God more than ever. We tell Him we are sorry and ask Him to forgive us. God can give us wisdom to make the right choice in doing good, and He can change us.

If we wait till we are good enough, we will never pray at all.

Psalm 51:1, 2; Luke 18:13, 14.

How can God be everywhere listening to my prayer?

Remember that God is spirit, not just a physical person. God is all-powerful! That is, He can do anything. He can be in all places. He knows everything. God is always with us and He loves us and will listen to our prayers. 2 Chronicles 2:6; Job 42:2, 3; Psalm 139:2–8.

• How do we pray?

People pray in many different ways. There is no set way to pray. We can talk to God using our own words. We don't have to follow a written prayer. You can pray aloud or pray silently because God knows our thoughts. You can pray sitting at your desk, at school, on the playground, at piano practice—simply anywhere. God is happy to hear us when we ask Him for help right when we need it.

But remember, when we pray, we are talking with the Creator of everything. We need to be very respectful toward God and not make funny remarks or jokes about prayer.

Jeremiah 29:13; Matthew 6:9–13; Ephesians 6:18.

Does God always give us what we pray for?

God loves us and He will give us what is good for us. Sometimes we pray for things that will hurt us or hurt others, or we pray with a selfish motive, so God does not give us what we asked for. At other times, we may ask for things that are good, but it's not part of God's plan. Sometimes, God wants us to wait because He knows that it is better for us to wait. So God always answers our prayers. He may say:

> GO NO SLOW

When we pray for our loved ones not to die but they die, does it mean God doesn't love them?

No, not at all. God loves everyone in the world. That is why He sent His Son, Jesus, to die for us on the cross. Every person has to die because of sin, but God has promised us eternal life in heaven with Him if we accept Him. We commit our loved ones to God and believe that He will do what is best for them.
