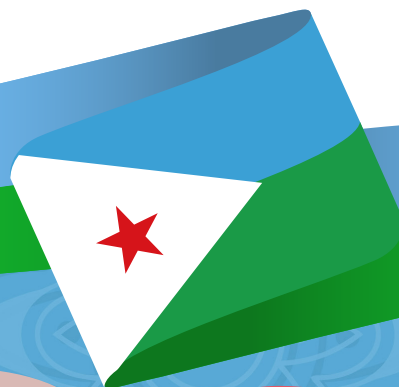


PRAY FOR *Djibouti*
