


## INVISIBLE SUN

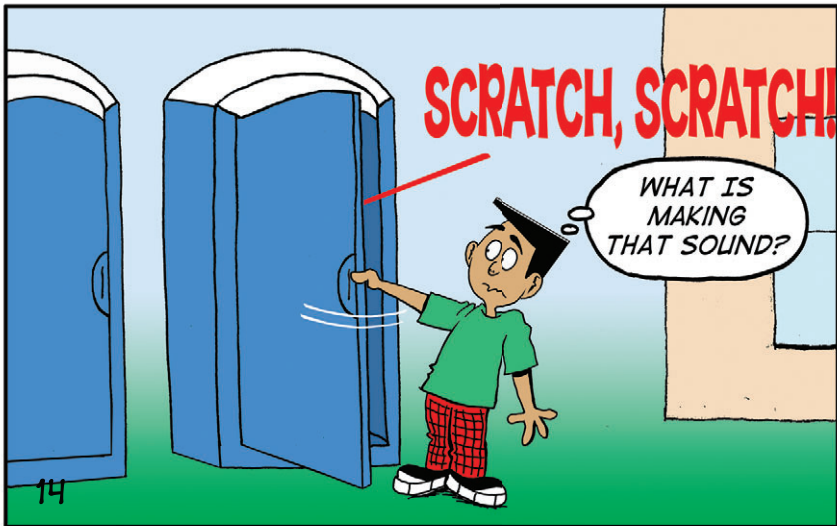

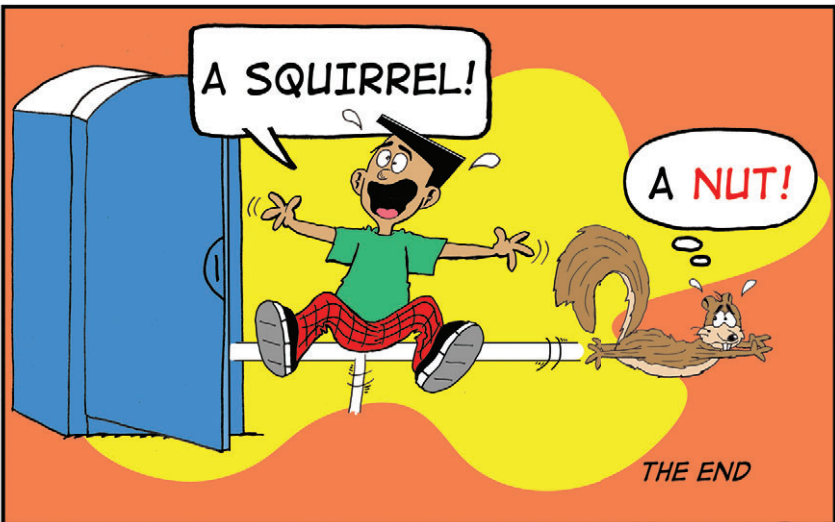

(Genesis 2:2, 3).



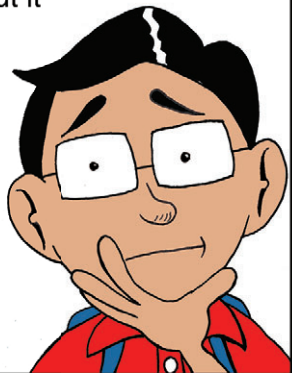


## What Will YOU Do About the Sabbath?

## FUN FACTS

- Some people mistakenly believe the term “Lord’s Day” means Sunday. But God Himself called the seventh day of the week the “Lord’s Holy Day” (Isaiah 58:13, International Children’s Bible and other versions).
- In many languages around the world, the word for Saturday shows a connection to the Bible Sabbath. Examples include “sabado” (Spanish) and “subbota” (Russian).
- Jesus kept the seventh day of the week as His Sabbath. (See Luke 4:16.) The Bible never mentions a change to God’s holy day.
